Plans for March include working more on cognitive skills. We will be working on numbers, letters, shapes, sizing, opposites, patterns and 1 to 1 correspondence. Our dramatic play centers have been a veterinary clinic and a post office. We plan on also having a construction center.

The children are still working on identifying and learning their addresses using our helper box, birthdays will be added next. With the weather words, the children try to identify the words using beginning sounds and are doing quite well.

After all that there was still time for the children to do puzzles, look at books and play quietly. Our thanks to all the parents for your cooperation in providing drop off and pick up at the library.

This month, we will be going on another field trip. We will all meet at Grand Oaks Recreation Center for a fun-filled day of sports activities. Drop off and pick up will be at the recreation center (regular class times). More information regarding this field trip will be sent home with your child.
